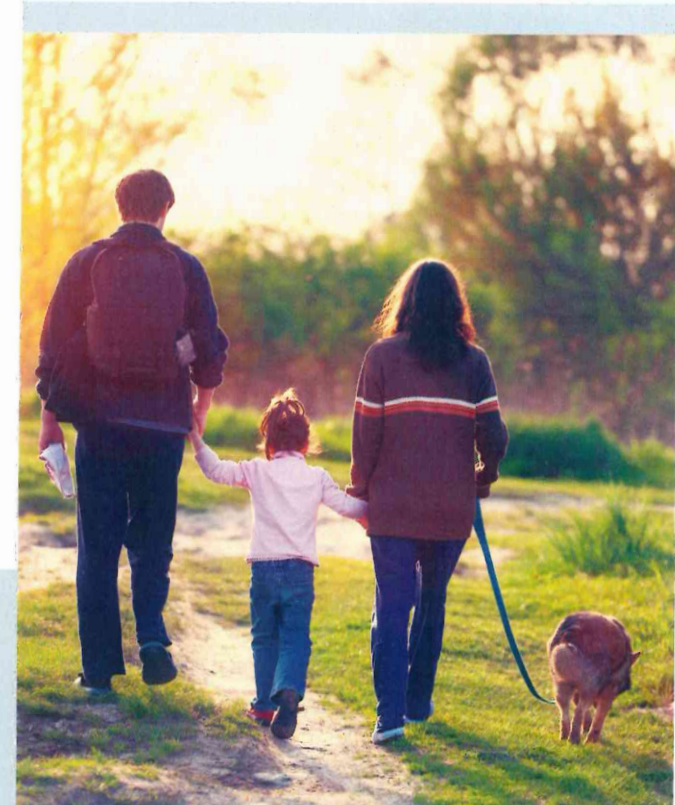

## What Services are Available?

- Timely crisis intervention, including:
  - 24/7 call line and walk-in locations staffed with professionals
  - Assessment team who evaluates the crisis on-site
  - Care plan development
- Stabilization
- Evaluation
- Treatment
- Home or site-based therapeutic support
- Access to:
  - Intensive psychiatric and behavioral health services
  - Education, training, and follow-up support

## Where are These Services Available?

These services are available in nine counties representing two Colorado regions: Delta, Garfield, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Mesa, Montrose, Ouray, and San Miguel counties on the Western Slope, and Larimer County on the Front Range.

## How are These Services Offered?

These services are offered through a pilot program on the Western Slope and in Larimer County. This program was developed to help individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities get access to necessary services, as well as to integrate the behavioral health and intellectual & developmental disabilities systems.

## What Organizations are Involved?

**Rocky Mountain Health Plans (RMHP)** is conducting the program in partnership with the following organizations on the Western Slope:

- Strive, a community-based support services organization for individuals with developmental disabilities
- Mind Springs Health, a network of community mental health centers
- Mountain Valley Developmental Services, which provides a comprehensive array of services to children and adults with developmental disabilities
- The Center for Mental Health - Montrose, a center that has been providing behavioral health services since 1964
- Community Options, Inc., which provides and coordinates services and supports to people with developmental disabilities

In Larimer County, RMHP is working with **Foothills Gateway, Inc.**, a community-based support services organization for individuals with developmental disabilities and **SummitStone Health Partners**, a behavioral health and Colorado Crisis center providing mental health and addiction treatment services.
